WHEREAS, is known that three behaviors – poor nutrition, lack of exercise and tobacco use – are the main causes of the four chronic illnesses: cardiovascular disease and stroke, cancer Type 2 diabetes and respiratory conditions, which account for more than half of the deaths in San Diego County residents: and

WHEREAS, the County of San Diego launched the Live Well San Diego Initiative to serve as a blueprint for achieving the vision of healthy safe and thriving communities;

WHEREAS, on July 13, 2010 and October 9, 2012, the San Diego Board of Supervisors adopted the Building Better Health and Living Safely strategies, the first two components of Live Well San Diego encouraging all residents of the county to participate programs to build better heath and increase safety as individuals, families and communities; and

WHEREAS, the Julian Union High School District recognizes the link between student health and learning and is committed to providing a comprehensive learning environment that supports and promotes wellness, healthy eating, nutrition education, physical education, and activity for our students; and

WHEREAS, the Julian Union High School District provides services for two schools and 163 students, 9-12; and

WHEREAS, the District recognizes the importance of eating local, fresh, healthy and delicious farm to school food to the health, well-being, and academic success of students as a core component of the Julian Nutrition Program, and

WHEREAS, the Julian Union High School District is associated with the Julian Pathways Center for Families, Schools, and Community Partnerships; and

WHEREAS, the District is committed to improving the health of its students and has developed a Wellness Plan with Staff, Student and Parent participation; and

WHEREAS, around 66% of all students are eligible and participate in CIF sports each season; and

WHEREAS, the District collaborates with public agencies and community groups to enhance and ensure student safety; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved, that through these many efforts, the Julian Union High School Board of Trustees supports the Building Better Health and Living Safely strategies and joins the Live Well San Diego Initiative.
