*WHEREAS, MAAC provides a safe environment for children and families and assists at-risk populations in obtaining government and community services that will guide the family unit to remain, or become, gainfully employed and self-sustaining; and*

*WHEREAS, MAAC encourages healthy living by providing underserved populations access to early childhood education, physical and mental health services, nutrition education, nutritious meals and nature based playgrounds; and*

*WHEREAS, the County of San Diego is committed to recognizing and honoring those organizations who are dedicated to the best ideals of public service, and MAAC is one such worthy organization; NOW THEREFORE,*
