Whereas, the American Cancer Society is the nationwide, community-based, voluntary health organization dedicated to eliminating cancer as a major health problem by preventing cancer, saving lives, and diminishing suffering from cancer, through research, education, advocacy, and service; and

Whereas, by becoming a partner with Live Well San Diego, the American Cancer Society will join a network of like-minded organizations dedicated to enhancing quality of life for members of our community and cancer patients throughout San Diego County.

It is RESOLVED, on November 1, 2016, that the San Diego Regional Leadership Council approves the partnership with the County of San Diego's Live Well San Diego Program.
